

Our learning this half-term... - Year 3

English	Maths	Wider Curriculum
<p>In English this half term we will be learning about narrative texts and persuasive writing.</p> <p>We will be learning about the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Features of a narrative text.• Language of a narrative text.• Choice of precise vocabulary to engage the reader and create good description• Choice of persuasive language.• Use of appropriate vocabulary for different text types. <p>To support your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Share some narrative texts you may have at home. See if your child can identify any language features including adjectives, similes and onomatopoeia.• Create a persuasive letter together about something you are passionate about.	<p>In Maths this half term we will be covering the following skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Time – reading both analogue and digital to the nearest minute, understanding the 24 hour clock, am and pm,• Fractions – recognise, find and write fractions of shape, length and objects. Counting in tenths and finding tenths. Comparing fractions.• Securing multiplication and division – deepening children’s understanding of multiplication and division, word problems, multiplying by six and eight.• Problem Solving – solving problems in a range of contexts and from a range of topics covered so far. <p>To help your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Focusing on telling the time to the nearest minute on both analogue and digital clocks. Talking about when things are done either in the am or pm.• Identifying fractions in the real world. Talking about when you would use fractions. Counting in tenths.• Learn 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 times tables.• Practise division skills.• Give children opportunities to apply their maths skills in the real world.	<p>Humanities</p> <p>In Humanities this half term, we will be learning about the Stone Age to Iron Age. We will focussing our learning on how people in the Stone and Iron Age lived and what makes the periods of time unique in history.</p> <p>Science</p> <p>In Science this half term, our learning is focussed on Rocks. We will learn about the different types of rock and their properties.</p> <p>PE</p> <p>Outdoor PE - Team Building Activities</p> <p>Indoor PE - Dance</p> <p>Ed for Life</p> <p>In Ed for Life we will be learning about safety whilst using the internet.</p> <p>Computing</p> <p>Our learning in Computing this half term focuses developing our programming skills using the Scratch app.</p> <p>Design and Technology</p> <p>We will be learning about Healthy Snacks.</p>
