





Our learning this half-term... - Year 1

Literacy	Maths	Wider Curriculum
<p>In Literacy this half term we will be studying stories with patterned language and recounts.</p> <p>We will be covering the following skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Retelling a story that we have been learning about. Looking at the structure of stories with patterned language. Using full sentences in our writing. Writing descriptions, using adjectives, adverbs and similes. Reading recounts and identifying the features; sequencing of events, time adverbials, past tense. Proof-reading work to check for errors with spelling and punctuation. Writing our own recounts, using the correct features. <p>To support your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Read together different stories. Practice retelling stories your child is already familiar with. Practice writing a story, focussing on the beginning, middle and end. Listen to or read recounts, for example, Barnaby Bear's recounts on the internet. Practice writing recounts about something they have done. Encourage your child to practise their handwriting. 	<p>In Maths this half term we will be covering the following skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place value for numbers up to 50. Addition and subtraction to 20. Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's with fluency. Fractions Measuring length and mass.  <p>To help your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise counting in 2's 5's and 10's with your child. Practise counting back and forth to 50. Practise reading and writing numbers up to 50. Measuring objects using the correct. Continue to practice number bonds to 10 or 	<p>History</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In History this term we will be looking at Florence Nightingale and the impact her life and actions have had on our lives today.  <p>Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In science this term we will be conducting a range of experiments to explore properties of materials. We will look at floating and sinking, structures, electricity and healthy eating. <p>Ed for life/Philosophy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be looking at the celebration Easter in detail and its importance. <p>PE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Outdoor PE - Hit, Catch, Run (Please remember suitable clothing for PE outdoors!) Indoor PE - Dance <p>Computing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In computing we will be creating our own eBooks on a topic we are looking at this term. We will use Book Creator to do this and learn how to copy images, add text, add audio and then present them at the end of term.

Homework will be set weekly (Wednesday) alongside reading, learn its and spellings which you will find in your child's planner. Please support your child with this and ensure homework books are back in school for marking on a Monday!
