

## Our learning this half-term... - Year 3

English	Maths	Wider Curriculum
In English this half term we will be learning doing a novel study on the text The Iron Man.  We will be learning about the following:  • Features of a fiction text.  • Language of a fiction text.  • Choice of adventurous vocabulary to engage the reader.  • Use of appropriate verb tenses.  To support your child with this aspect of learning you could:  • Share some fiction texts you may have at home. See if your child can identify any language features including adjectives, similes and onomatopoeia.  • Create a fiction text together including adventurous word choices.	In Maths this half term we will be covering the following skills:  • Length and Measure • Multiplication and Division.  To help your child with this aspect of learning you could:  • Consolidate 2, 5, 10 and 3 times tables. • Learn the breadth of times tables with particular focus on 4 and 8.  • Read time on analogue clocks both in 24 and 12 hour clocks, including Roman Numerals. • Understand and compare different units of time e.g. leap year, decade, century etc. • Identify fractions in everyday life, talk about how they are used.	Humanities  In Humanities this half term, we will be learning about what makes Great Britain great. We will be improving our knowledge and understanding of the countries that make up the UK as well as our map skills.  Science  In Science this half term, our learning is focussed on Animals including Humans. We will learn about a balanced diet and the human skeleton.  PE  Outdoor PE - Football (Please remember suitable clothing for PE outdoors including Trainers and Shin pads)  Indoor PE - Gymnastic  Philosophy  In Philosophy we will be learning about the teaching of the parables of Jesus and what they teach Christians.  Computing  Our learning in Computing this half term focuses developing our skills when using PowerPoint. We will be learning about the importance of copyright and importing sounds into our documents.  Art and Design Technology  We will be learning about Natural Materials and Healthy Snacks.
