


Our learning this half-term... - Year 4

English	Maths	Wider Curriculum
<p>In English this half term we will be learning about the story of 'The Journey to the River Sea' in fictional writing and we will then be looking at Newspaper articles, focussing on different perspectives of characters.</p> <p>To support your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read appropriate texts on each genre to help your child remember the vocabulary used which will support them for their imitation writing. • Reading various newspaper articles to discuss the language used and different perspective. Also discuss how quotes are used to build information and the formal language used throughout. 	<p>In Maths this half term we will be covering the following skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Data (pictograms, bar charts and line graphs) • Time <p>To help your child with this aspect of learning you could:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read the time, focusing on 'past the hour' and 'to the hour' as well as the 24 hour clock. • Collect information around the house using tallies & frequency tables. • Practice times tables your child is focusing on each week. 	<p><u>Humanities</u></p> <p>In Geography this half term, we will be learning about Norway.</p> <p><u>Science</u></p> <p>In Science this half term, our learning is focussed on Scientists and Inventors. We will be looking at inventors such as Alexander Graham-Bell, Thomas Edison, Washington Sheffield, Lord Kelvin, Joseph Priestley and Antoine Lavoisier.</p> <p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Outdoor PE - Rugby (Please remember suitable clothing for PE outdoors including Trainers and Shin pads)</p> <p>Indoor PE - Dance</p> <p><u>Philosophy</u></p> <p>In Philosophy this half term, we will be learning about Christianity, in particular the importance baptism, the holy trinity and the symbolism of water.</p> <p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Our learning in Computing this half term focuses on creating algorithms using the 'Scratch' software.</p> <p><u>Creativity</u></p> <p>In Design Technology this half term, we will be learning about Lighthouses and in Art we will be looking at observational drawings by artists Georgia O'Keeffe and Margaret Mee.</p>

Homework will continue to be set weekly (Friday) alongside reading, times tables and spellings. Please support your child with this and ensure homework books are back in school for marking on a Wednesday! 😊
